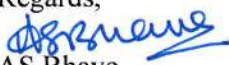

Please refer to the above correspondence seeking permission for berthing and unloading of LNG cargo at M/s Konkan LNG Ltd.'s (KLL) LNG Terminal Jetty at Dabhol w.e.f. 26.05.2025 for all weather conditions.

2. It is noted from the above correspondence that the all activities related to breakwater project at KLL Dabhol have been completed and the Directorate General of Shipping, Mumbai issued a "Full term Certificate of Compliance for NSPC" to Konkan LNG on 14.5.2025, which is valid for five years, i.e. 08.03.2030, subject to compliance with the conditions laid out in the Joint Inspection Report and as per the Annexure "P" attached to the Certificate of Compliance for NSPC.

3. Your proposal has been examined through Regional Port Officer, Ratnagiri Group of Ports, MMB who recommended your proposal, vide his letter dtd.21.05.2025 for granting requisite permission, in order to facilitate berthing and unloading of LNG cargo.

4. In accordance with the above, considering your request, the undersigned is pleased to grant you permission under the provisions of Indian Ports Act, 1908, and Maharashtra Maritime Board Act, 1996, for berthing and unloading of LNG cargo at KLL's LNG Terminal jetty at Dabhol, Dist. Ratnagiri, subject to following terms and conditions:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- (i) This permission shall remain valid for the period from **26.05.2025 to 25.05.2026**.
- (ii) KLL shall obtain necessary permissions from concerned authorities, wherever applicable, prior to commencement of LNG shipment.

- (iii) LNG being the hazardous cargo, KLL shall ensure that all necessary arrangements are in place and working satisfactorily for reception and storage of LNG.
- (iv) KLL shall submit details of vessels and crew thereon, bringing LNG to Regional Ports Officer, Ratnagiri Group of Ports and Port Inspector, Dabhol Port, well in advance. The LNG vessels and crew thereon, involved in cargo operations should hold proper certificates issued by competent authorities.
- (v) The shipments of LNG should be carried out in consultation with Regional Port Officer, Ratnagiri Group of Ports, MMB and Port Inspector, Dabhol Port, MMB.
- (vi) KLL shall ensure that the proposed shipments do not obstruct the existing shipping/fishing activities in that area. For this purpose, your representative should always keep in touch with Regional Ports Officer, Ratnagiri Group of Ports and Port Inspector, Dabhol Port.
- (vii) KLL will have to pay the landing /shipping charges (i.e. wharfage charges) as per the rate applicable for captive jetty in respect of captive cargo and one & half times charges in respect of merchant cargo, as per Government of Maharashtra Notification in force from time to time. These charges, along with other applicable statutory charges, are to be remitted to Port Inspector, Dabhol Port, prior to departure of the vessel. Any delay in payment will attract an interest @18% per annum from the date on which it becomes due for payment till the same is cleared.
- (viii) KLL will have to pay all port dues and other relevant charges along with other applicable statutory charges for vessels calling at LNG jetty to Port Inspector, Dabhol Port as per Government of Maharashtra Notification in force from time to time. Any delay in payment will attract an interest @18% per annum from the date on which it becomes due for payment till the same is cleared.
- (ix) KLL shall take due precautions to avoid spillage / pollution due to handling.
- (x) KLL shall carry out the shipments during calm weather only for safety purpose after taking into consideration the weather warnings issued by IMD from time to time. Although the fair season has commenced from 01 September 2024, the possibility of squally weather during the period from October to December cannot be ruled out. You must keep a close watch on such weather occurrences and before the onset of any such weather conditions must suspend all operations during such period without even waiting for any formal communication from the authority.
- (xi) KLL shall maintain full-fledged safety and security system to ensure safe and proper handling of LNG.
- (xii) Any Central / State Government Authority including any Authority for port-related works must be allowed entry into the area of operation with full cooperation from the company.
- (xiii) KLL shall strictly observe all statutory Port Regulations and orders issued from time to time.
- (xiv) In case of any controversy on the operations, the decision of the Chief Executive Officer, MMB shall be final and binding on the company.

- (xv) KLL will have to pay processing fees of Rs. 11,800/- (Rs. Eleven thousand eight hundred only) (Processing fees Rs. 10,000/- + GST 18% Rs. 1,800/-) through demand draft drawn in favour of **"Maharashtra Maritime Board, Mumbai"**.
- (xvi) KLL shall strictly observe any other condition intimated by MMB from time to time.
- (xvii) In case of breach of any of the condition(s) mentioned above, the undersigned reserves the right to take appropriate action as deemed fit.

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General Terms & Conditions

Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) undertakes to provide service to its customer subject to the terms & conditions mentioned here-

1. Area of Application

1.1 All Orders accepted by **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)** (Collectively "ES") will be governed by these General Terms and Conditions of Sales (the "Terms and Conditions"), including orders placed by telephone which have not been confirmed in writing and orders made by delivery of samples. A contract with these Terms and Conditions comes into being when an order that has been placed with ES is accepted by ES. An order placed with ES is considered as accepted by ES when (a) ES proceeds to fulfil that order, without need for any written confirmation from ES or (b) ES accept the order in writing.

1.2 All reports will be issued with the legal name i.e. **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)**

1.3 These Terms and Conditions supersede and replace all prior verbal or written price quotations and agreements between the parties and, unless specifically indicated otherwise therein, take precedence over all conflicting or inconsistent provisions of subsequent written agreements between the parties. No officer (other than the Managing Director of ES), employee, agent or subcontractor of ES has the authority to alter or waive any of these Terms and Conditions or to make any representation which conflicts with or purports to override any of these Terms and Conditions; and no such alteration, waiver or representation shall be binding upon ES, unless it is in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES.

2. Placement of Order

2.1 A customer order will be valid only if it is sent by mail or fax or other electronic message on letterhead of the customer or by using ES-approved sample Test request form or electronic order forms and the commercial aspects of the order which are not specifically set out in these Terms and Conditions (including price, estimated turnaround times and delivery date) must be agreed at the time of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

2.2 Unless specifically accepted in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES, any terms proposed or submitted by a customer at any time (including, but not limited to, terms or provisions in the customer's purchase order-instructions or other document) which differ from these Terms and Conditions are rejected as a material alteration of these Terms and Conditions and shall be of no force or effect. Furthermore, special terms or conditions of prior orders, including special pricing, will not automatically apply to subsequent orders. Each order accepted by ES will be treated as a separate contract between ES and the customer.

2.3 Any logistic service off-site of the laboratory must be paid in full, unless it has been cancelled or modified by the customer at least forty eight hours (48) in advance for collection services, ninety six (96) hours in advance for sampling services and one (1) week in advance for auditing services.

3. Price and Terms of Payment

3.1 If the acknowledgment of an order does not state otherwise, ES' prices apply "ex works", excluding packaging, which is charged separately. Any additional cost or disbursement (e.g. incurred by ES in connection with the order) must be paid by the customer.

3.2 Prices are exclusive of all applicable taxes (GST or Other taxes) and are based on tariffs in force at the day of the remittance of the order. Applicable taxes are those in force at the date of invoicing.

3.3 Unless specifically agreed otherwise by ES in its acceptance of an order, payment of all invoices is due strictly within 30 days of the invoice date. Any dispute about invoices must be raised within 30 days of the invoice date. The challenge of any test result will not entitle a customer to defer payment. Any invoice which remains outstanding after due date, may be additionally charged with an administrative penalty of Rupees Two hundred (Rs.200) and may carry interest as per MSMED Act.

3.4 Invoices are subject to a minimum invoice charge of Rupees two Hundred fifty (Rs.250).

3.5 The invoice settlement method is Cheque, bank transfer or direct debit. Any other method of payment must receive prior agreement from ES. The customer undertakes to provide bank account details.

3.6 ES is entitled to require payment of up to 100% of the quoted order price as a condition of acceptance.

4. Duties of Customer in Delivering Samples or Materials

4.1 The samples or materials must be in a condition that makes the preparation of reports/analyses or the production of ordered products possible without difficulty. ES is entitled to conduct an initial examination of the samples or materials to check their condition before processing the samples, drawing up a report or using them in production. The customer shall bear the costs of this initial examination, if the samples or materials do not comply with the requirements described in this clause 4.1. If the result of the initial examination is that an analysis or production is impossible or is possible only under more difficult conditions than originally anticipated (for example, because the samples or materials have been interspersed with foreign materials or substances that were not reported by the customer or are degraded) ES shall be entitled to terminate or interrupt the order and the customer shall bear costs incurred by ES to that point.

4.2 The customer must ensure, and hereby warrants, that no sample poses any danger, inducing on its site, during transportation, in the laboratory or otherwise to ES premises, instruments, personnel or representatives. It is the customer's responsibility to insure compliance with hazardous waste regulations, including regarding information, transportation and disposal and to inform ES personnel or representatives about sample health and safety concerns, including any known or suspected toxic or other contaminant that may be present in the sample and its likely level of contamination as well as the risks to ES premises, instruments, personnel and representatives related to the contamination. The customer shall be responsible for, and indemnifies ES against, all costs, damages, liabilities and injuries that may be caused to or incurred by ES or its personnel or representatives including on the sampling site, during the transportation or in the laboratory by the customer's sample or by sampling site conditions. The customer shall bear all extraordinary costs for adequate disposal of hazardous waste resulting from the sample, whether or not described as hazardous waste. At ES' request, the customer must provide ES with the exact composition of the samples.

5. Property Rights on Sample Material and Sample Storage

5.1 All samples become the property of ES to the extent necessary for the performance of the order. Unless the customer pays for storage, ES shall have no obligation or liability for samples sent to ES for storage, including samples requiring refrigeration however ES retains the sample for three months. If the customer pays for further storage, ES will take commercially reasonable steps to store the samples, according to professional practice.

5.2 Sample will be destroyed after one month from the date of release of test report unless specified by regulatory or ES and the customer have agreed in writing on the terms of ES' retention of the sample. ES also can dispose of or destroy the samples after the agreed upon retention period, without further notice and at customer's cost, should an extra cost for ES arise to comply with any regulation (for example, with respect to disposal of hazardous waste). If the customer requests the return of unneeded sample material, ES will return them to the customer, at the customer's cost and risk.

5.3 The sample description is not verified in all cases and is given "as described by customer". Sample not drawn by us and analysis conducted on "as received bases". Unless specified otherwise

6. Delivery Dates, Turnaround Time

6.1 Delivery dates and turnaround times are estimates and do not constitute a commitment by ES. Nevertheless, ES shall make commercially reasonable efforts to meet its estimated deadlines.

6.2 Results are generally sent by email and/or by mail, or via other electronic means, to the attention of the persons indicated by the customer in the order, promptly after the analysis is completed.

7. Transfer of Property

7.1 Title in any analysis results, products, equipment, software or similar supplied by ES to the customer will remain with ES until all invoices in respect thereof have been paid by the customer in full, and until such full payment, the customer shall have no property rights or other rights to use them. In addition, even if ES has accepted and begun to fulfil an order, ES has the right at any time stop processing that order and to stop doing any work for a customer if that customer is late in paying any amount due to ES, whether for that or any other order.

7.2 Even after payment in full by the customer, ES shall retain the right to store, use and publish all analysis results in an anonymous form which does not identify the customer.

8. Limited Warranties and responsibilities

8.1 Orders are handled in the conditions available to ES in accordance with the current state of technology and methods developed and generally applied by ES and the results may not always be 100% exact and/ or relevant. 12.2 ES shall use commercially reasonable efforts to keep all analysis results and service reports confidential, subject to ES' rights set forth in clause 7.2 and the right to use them in order to demonstrate its entitlement to payment for services rendered.

12.3 Analysis results are prepared and supplied exclusively for the use of the customer and should not be divulged to a third party for any purposes without the prior written agreement of ES. Even if such written consent is given by ES, the customer (a) remains responsible for any consequences due to the divulgence of such results to a third party and any reliance of such third party on such results and (b) hereby agrees to indemnify the ES Indemnified Parties against any liability which the ES Indemnified Parties may incur as a result of such divulgence or any such third party reliance.

THE WARRANTIES, OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITIES OF ES CONTAINED IN THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ARE EXCLUSIVE.

13.2 These Terms and Conditions may be modified in writing from time to time by ES and orders will be governed by the most recent version of these Terms and Conditions that is in effect at the time ES accepts the order.

13.3 Should a court waive, limit or hold to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable any part of these Terms and Conditions, all other parts shall still apply to the greatest extent possible.

13.4 Failure by either ES or the customer to exercise the rights under these Terms and Conditions shall not constitute a waiver or forfeiture of such rights.

14. Governing Law/ Jurisdiction

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General Terms & Conditions

Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) undertakes to provide service to its customer subject to the terms & conditions mentioned here-

1. Area of Application

1.1 All Orders accepted by **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)** (Collectively "ES") will be governed by these General Terms and Conditions of Sales (the "Terms and Conditions"), including orders placed by telephone which have not been confirmed in writing and orders made by delivery of samples. A contract with these Terms and Conditions comes into being when an order that has been placed with ES is accepted by ES. An order placed with ES is considered as accepted by ES when (a) ES proceeds to fulfil that order, without need for any written confirmation from ES or (b) ES accept the order in writing.

1.2 All reports will be issued with the legal name i.e. **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)**

1.3 These Terms and Conditions supersede and replace all prior verbal or written price quotations and agreements between the parties and, unless specifically indicated otherwise therein, take precedence over all conflicting or inconsistent provisions of subsequent written agreements between the parties. No officer (other than the Managing Director of ES), employee, agent or subcontractor of ES has the authority to alter or waive any of these Terms and Conditions or to make any representation which conflicts with or purports to override any of these Terms and Conditions; and no such alteration, waiver or representation shall be binding upon ES, unless it is in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES.

2. Placement of Order

2.1 A customer order will be valid only if it is sent by mail or fax or other electronic message on letterhead of the customer or by using ES-approved sample Test request form or electronic order forms and the commercial aspects of the order which are not specifically set out in these Terms and Conditions (including price, estimated turnaround times and delivery date) must be agreed at the time of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

2.2 Unless specifically accepted in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES, any terms proposed or submitted by a customer at any time (including, but not limited to, terms or provisions in the customer's purchase order-instructions or other document) which differ from these Terms and Conditions are rejected as a material alteration of these Terms and Conditions and shall be of no force or effect. Furthermore, special terms or conditions of prior orders, including special pricing, will not automatically apply to subsequent orders. Each order accepted by ES will be treated as a separate contract between ES and the customer.

2.3 Any logistic service off-site of the laboratory must be paid in full, unless it has been cancelled or modified by the customer at least forty eight hours (48) in advance for collection services, ninety six (96) hours in advance for sampling services and one (1) week in advance for auditing services.

3. Price and Terms of Payment

3.1 If the acknowledgment of an order does not state otherwise, ES' prices apply "ex works", excluding packaging, which is charged separately. Any additional cost or disbursement (e.g. incurred by ES in connection with the order) must be paid by the customer.

3.2 Prices are exclusive of all applicable taxes (GST or Other taxes) and are based on tariffs in force at the day of the remittance of the order. Applicable taxes are those in force at the date of invoicing.

3.3 Unless specifically agreed otherwise by ES in its acceptance of an order, payment of all invoices is due strictly within 30 days of the invoice date. Any dispute about invoices must be raised within 30 days of the invoice date. The challenge of any test result will not entitle a customer to defer payment. Any invoice which remains outstanding after due date, may be additionally charged with an administrative penalty of Rupees Two hundred (Rs.200) and may carry interest as per MSMED Act.

3.5 The invoice settlement method is Cheque, bank transfer or direct debit. Any other method of payment must receive prior agreement from ES. The customer undertakes to provide bank account details.

3.6 ES is entitled to require payment of up to 100% of the quoted order price as a condition of acceptance.

4. Duties of Customer in Delivering Samples or Materials

4.1 The samples or materials must be in a condition that makes the preparation of reports/analyses or the production of ordered products possible without difficulty. ES is entitled to conduct an initial examination of the samples or materials to check their condition before processing the samples, drawing up a report or using them in production. The customer shall bear the costs of this initial examination, if the samples or materials do not comply with the requirements described in this clause 4.1. If the result of the initial examination is that an analysis or production is impossible or is possible only under more difficult conditions than originally anticipated (for example, because the samples or materials have been interspersed with foreign materials or substances that were not reported by the customer or are degraded) ES shall be entitled to terminate or interrupt the order and the customer shall bear costs incurred by ES to that point.

4.2 The customer must ensure, and hereby warrants, that no sample poses any danger, inducing on its site, during transportation, in the laboratory or otherwise to ES premises, instruments, personnel or representatives. It is the customer's responsibility to insure compliance with hazardous waste regulations, including regarding information, transportation and disposal and to inform ES personnel or representatives about sample health and safety concerns, including any known or suspected toxic or other contaminant that may be present in the sample and its likely level of contamination as well as the risks to ES premises, instruments, personnel and representatives related to the contamination. 5.1 All samples become the property of ES to the extent necessary for the performance of the order. If the customer pays for further storage, ES will take commercially reasonable steps to store the samples, according to professional practice.

5.2 Sample will be destroyed after one month from the date of release of test report unless specified by regulatory or ES and the customer have agreed in writing on the terms of ES' retention of the sample. ES also can dispose of or destroy the samples after the agreed upon retention period, without further notice and at customer's cost, should an extra cost for ES arise to comply with any regulation (for example, with respect to disposal of hazardous waste). 6. Delivery Dates, Turnaround Time

6.1 Delivery dates and turnaround times are estimates and do not constitute a commitment by ES. Nevertheless, ES shall make commercially reasonable efforts to meet its estimated deadlines.

6.2 Results are generally sent by email and/or by mail, or via other electronic means, to the attention of the persons indicated by the customer in the order, promptly after the analysis is completed.

7. Transfer of Property

7.1 Title in any analysis results, products, equipment, software or similar supplied by ES to the customer will remain with ES until all invoices in respect thereof have been paid by the customer in full, and until such full payment, the customer shall have no property rights or other rights to use them. In addition, even if ES has accepted and begun to fulfil an order, ES has the right at any time stop processing that order and to stop doing any work for a customer if that customer is late in paying any amount due to ES, whether for that or any other order.

7.2 Even after payment in full by the customer, ES shall retain the right to store, use and publish all analysis results in an anonymous form which does not identify the customer.

8. Limited Warranties and responsibilities

12.1 ES shall be entitled to save and process personal or commercial data received from the customer in any way, no matter whether such data stem from the customer directly or from a third party and shall use commercially reasonable efforts to keep such data confidential, in compliance with applicable law.

12.2 ES shall use commercially reasonable efforts to keep all analysis results and service reports confidential, subject to ES' rights set forth in clause 7.2 and the right to use them in order to demonstrate its entitlement to payment for services rendered.

12.3 Analysis results are prepared and supplied exclusively for the use of the customer and should not be divulged to a third party for any purposes without the prior written agreement of ES. Even if such written consent is given by ES, the customer (a) remains responsible for any consequences due to the divulgence of such results to a third party and any reliance of such third party on such results and (b) hereby agrees to indemnify the ES Indemnified Parties against any liability which the ES Indemnified Parties may incur as a result of such divulgence or any such third party reliance.

13.1 ALL TERMS, CONDITIONS AND WARRANTIES (INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY AS TO MERCHANTABILITY QUALITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE) AS TO THE MANNER, QUALITY AND TIMING OF THE TESTING SERVICE AND RESULTS, EQUIPMENT, PRODUCTS OR SOFTWARE SUPPLIED BY ES ARE EXCLUDED TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW. THE WARRANTIES, OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITIES OF ES CONTAINED IN THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ARE EXCLUSIVE.

13.2 These Terms and Conditions may be modified in writing from time to time by ES and orders will be governed by the most recent version of these Terms and Conditions that is in effect at the time ES accepts the order.

13.3 Should a court waive, limit or hold to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable any part of these Terms and Conditions, all other parts shall still apply to the greatest extent possible.

General Terms & Conditions

Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) undertakes to provide service to its customer subject to the terms & conditions mentioned here-

1. Area of Application

1.1 All Orders accepted by Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) (Collectively "ES") will be governed by these General Terms and Conditions of Sales (the "Terms and Conditions"), including orders placed by telephone which have not been confirmed in writing and orders made by delivery of samples. A contract with these Terms and Conditions comes into being when an order that has been placed with ES is accepted by ES. An order placed with ES is considered as accepted by ES when (a) ES proceeds to fulfil that order, without need for any written confirmation from ES or (b) ES accept the order in writing.

1.2 All reports will be issued with the legal name i.e. Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)

1.3 These Terms and Conditions supersede and replace all prior verbal or written price quotations and agreements between the parties and, unless specifically indicated otherwise therein, take precedence over all conflicting or inconsistent provisions of subsequent written agreements between the parties. 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General Terms & Conditions

Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) undertakes to provide service to its customer subject to the terms & conditions mentioned here-

1. Area of Application

1.1 All Orders accepted by **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)** (Collectively "ES") will be governed by these General Terms and Conditions of Sales (the "Terms and Conditions"), including orders placed by telephone which have not been confirmed in writing and orders made by delivery of samples. A contract with these Terms and Conditions comes into being when an order that has been placed with ES is accepted by ES. An order placed with ES is considered as accepted by ES when (a) ES proceeds to fulfil that order, without need for any written confirmation from ES or (b) ES accept the order in writing.

1.2 All reports will be issued with the legal name i.e. **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)**

1.3 These Terms and Conditions supersede and replace all prior verbal or written price quotations and agreements between the parties and, unless specifically indicated otherwise therein, take precedence over all conflicting or inconsistent provisions of subsequent written agreements between the parties. No officer (other than the Managing Director of ES), employee, agent or subcontractor of ES, has the authority to alter or waive any of these Terms and Conditions or to make any representation which conflicts with or purports to override any of these Terms and Conditions; and no such alteration, waiver or representation shall be binding upon ES, unless it is in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES.

2. Placement of Order

2.1 A customer order will be valid only if it is sent by mail or fax or other electronic message on letterhead of the customer or by using ES-approved sample Test request form or electronic order forms and the commercial aspects of the order which are not specifically set out in these Terms and Conditions (including price, estimated turnaround times and delivery date) must be agreed at the time of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

2.2 Unless specifically accepted in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES, any terms proposed or submitted by a customer at any time (including, but not limited to, terms or provisions in the customer's purchase order-instructions or other document) which differ from these Terms and Conditions are rejected as a material alteration of these Terms and Conditions and shall be of no force or effect. Furthermore, special terms or conditions of prior orders, including special pricing, will not automatically apply to subsequent orders. Each order accepted by ES will be treated as a separate contract between ES and the customer.

2.3 Any logistic service off-site of the laboratory must be paid in full, unless it has been cancelled or modified by the customer at least forty eight hours (48) in advance for collection services, ninety six (96) hours in advance for sampling services and one (1) week in advance for auditing services.

3. Price and Terms of Payment

3.1 If the acknowledgment of an order does not state otherwise, ES' prices apply "ex works", excluding packaging, which is charged separately. Any additional cost or disbursement (e.g. incurred by ES in connection with the order) must be paid by the customer.

3.2 Prices are exclusive of all applicable taxes (GST or Other taxes) and are based on tariffs in force at the day of the remittance of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

3.3 Unless specifically agreed otherwise by ES in its acceptance of an order, payment of all invoices is due strictly within 30 days of the invoice date. Any dispute about invoices must be raised within 30 days of the invoice date. The challenge of any test result will not entitle a customer to defer payment. Any invoice which remains outstanding after due date, may be additionally charged with an administrative penalty of Rupees Two hundred (Rs.200) and may carry interest as per MSMED Act.

3.4 Invoices are subject to a minimum invoice charge of Rupees two Hundred fifty (Rs.250).

3.5 The invoice settlement method is Cheque, bank transfer or direct debit. Any other method of payment must receive prior agreement from ES. The customer undertakes to provide bank account details.

3.6 ES is entitled to require payment of up to 100% of the quoted order price as a condition of acceptance.

4. Duties of Customer in Delivering Samples or Materials

4.1 The samples or materials must be in a condition that makes the preparation of reports/analyses or the production of ordered products possible without difficulty. ES is entitled to conduct an initial examination of the samples or materials to check their condition before processing the samples, drawing up a report or using them in production. The customer shall bear the costs of this initial examination, if the samples or materials do not comply with the requirements described in this clause 4.1. If the result of the initial examination is that an analysis or production is impossible or is possible only under more difficult conditions than originally anticipated (for example, because the samples or materials have been interspersed with foreign materials or substances that were not reported by the customer or are degraded) ES shall be entitled to terminate or interrupt the order and the customer shall bear costs incurred by ES to that point.

4.2 The customer must ensure, and hereby warrants, that no sample poses any danger, inducing on its site, during transportation, in the laboratory or otherwise to ES premises, instruments, personnel or representatives. It is the customer's responsibility to insure compliance with hazardous waste regulations, including regarding information, transportation and disposal and to inform ES personnel or representatives about sample health and safety concerns, including any known or suspected toxic or other contaminant that may be present in the sample and its likely level of contamination as well as the risks to ES premises, instruments, personnel and representatives related to the contamination. The customer shall be responsible for, and indemnifies ES against, all costs, damages, liabilities and injuries that may be caused to or incurred by ES or its personnel or representatives including on the sampling site, during the transportation or in the laboratory by the customer's sample or by sampling site conditions. The customer shall bear all extraordinary costs for adequate disposal of hazardous waste resulting from the sample, whether or not described as hazardous waste. At ES' request, the customer must provide ES with the exact composition of the samples.

5. Property Rights on Sample Material and Sample Storage

5.1 All samples become the property of ES to the extent necessary for the performance of the order. Unless the customer pays for storage, ES shall have no obligation or liability for samples sent to ES for storage, including samples requiring refrigeration however ES retains the sample for three months. If the customer pays for further storage, ES will take commercially reasonable steps to store the samples, according to professional practice.

5.2 Sample will be destroyed after one month from the date of release of test report unless specified by regulatory or ES and the customer have agreed in writing on the terms of ES' retention of the sample. ES also can dispose of or destroy the samples after the agreed upon retention period, without further notice and at customer's cost, should an extra cost for ES arise to comply with any regulation (for example, with respect to disposal of hazardous waste). If the customer requests the return of unneeded sample material, ES will return them to the customer, at the customer's cost and risk.

6. Delivery Dates, Turnaround Time

6.1 Delivery dates and turnaround times are estimates and do not constitute a commitment by ES. Nevertheless, ES shall make commercially reasonable efforts to meet its estimated deadlines.

6.2 Results are generally sent by email and/or by mail, or via other electronic means, to the attention of the persons indicated by the customer in the order, promptly after the analysis is completed.

7. Transfer of Property

In addition, even if ES has accepted and begun to fulfil an order, ES has the right at any time stop processing that order and to stop doing any work for a customer if that customer is late in paying any amount due to ES, whether for that or any other order.

7.2 Even after payment in full by the customer, ES shall retain the right to store, use and publish all analysis results in an anonymous form which does not identify the customer.

8. Limited Warranties and responsibilities

This limited warranty expires three months after the delivery date of the samples, if the acknowledgement of the order does not specifically state otherwise. 9. Limitation of Liability

9.2 The ES Indemnifying Parties shall not be liable for any indirect, direct or consequential loss or damage (including, but not limited to, loss of business, profits, goodwill, and business opportunities or similar) incurred by the customer or by any third party.

9.3 It is a condition of ES' acceptance of an order that the customer indemnifies the ES Indemnifying Parties for any losses, injuries, claims and costs which the ES Indemnifying Parties may suffer as a result of arising from or in any way connected with its role under or services or products or software provided pursuant to these Terms and Conditions, accept to the extent that the ES Indemnifying Parties are required to bear them according to these Terms and Conditions, and by placing an order the customer agrees to provide that indemnification.

Otherwise the customer will be required to pay all costs, including sampling, transportation, analysis and disposal costs for the repeat analysis. No retest request will be accepted after return of tested sample.

11. Force Majeure

ES cannot be held liable for delays, errors, damages or other problems caused by events or circumstances which are unforeseen or beyond ES' reasonable control, or which result from compliance with governmental requests, laws and regulations.

12. Confidentiality & Processing of Customer Data

12.1 ES shall be entitled to save and process personal or commercial data received from the customer in any way, no matter whether such data stem from the customer directly or from a third party and shall use commercially reasonable efforts to keep such data confidential, in compliance with applicable law.

12.2 ES shall use commercially reasonable efforts to keep all analysis results and service reports confidential, subject to ES' rights set forth in clause 7.2 and the right to use them in order to demonstrate its entitlement to payment for services rendered.

12.3 Analysis results are prepared and supplied exclusively for the use of the customer and should not be divulged to a third party for any purposes without the prior written agreement of ES. In addition, the customer is required to maintain secrecy concerning all services provided by ES and their results as well as the composition of products and software delivered by ES. Analysis results are not to be publicly disclosed or exploited without the prior written consent of ES. Even if such written consent is given by ES, the customer (a) remains responsible for any consequences due to the divulgence of such results to a third party and any reliance of such third party on such results and (b) hereby agrees to indemnify the ES Indemnified Parties against any liability which the ES Indemnified Parties may incur as a result of such divulgence or any such third party reliance.

12.4 Test report certificate shall not be reproduced except in full, without written permission of laboratory

12.5 Test report certificate shall not be reproduced wholly or in parts and cannot be used as an evidence in a court of law and shall not be used in advertising media, without written permission of laboratory

13.1 ALL TERMS, CONDITIONS AND WARRANTIES (INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY AS TO MERCHANTABILITY QUALITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE) AS TO THE MANNER, QUALITY AND TIMING OF THE TESTING SERVICE AND RESULTS, EQUIPMENT, PRODUCTS OR SOFTWARE SUPPLIED BY ES ARE EXCLUDED TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW. THE WARRANTIES, OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITIES OF ES CONTAINED IN THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ARE EXCLUSIVE.

13.2 These Terms and Conditions may be modified in writing from time to time by ES and orders will be governed by the most recent version of these Terms and Conditions that is in effect at the time ES accepts the order.

13.3 Should a court waive, limit or hold to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable any part of these Terms and Conditions, all other parts shall still apply to the greatest extent possible.

13.4 Failure by either ES or the customer to exercise the rights under these Terms and Conditions shall not constitute a waiver or forfeiture of such rights.

14. Governing Law/ Jurisdiction

14.1 The construction, validity and performance of these Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the laws and the commercial courts of Delhi Jurisdiction, Delhi State, India in which the registered office of the ES company which accepted the order in question is located (including in cases involving multiple counsels for the defense or third-party respondents), which shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

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General Terms & Conditions

Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) undertakes to provide service to its customer subject to the terms & conditions mentioned here-

1. Area of Application

1.1 All Orders accepted by Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) (Collectively "ES") will be governed by these General Terms and Conditions of Sales (the "Terms and Conditions"), including orders placed by telephone which have not been confirmed in writing and orders made by delivery of samples. A contract with these Terms and Conditions comes into being when an order that has been placed with ES is accepted by ES. An order placed with ES is considered as accepted by ES when (a) ES proceeds to fulfil that order, without need for any written confirmation from ES or (b) ES accept the order in writing.

1.2 All reports will be issued with the legal name i.e. **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)**

1.3 These Terms and Conditions supersede and replace all prior verbal or written price quotations and agreements between the parties and, unless specifically indicated otherwise therein, take precedence over all conflicting or inconsistent provisions of subsequent written agreements between the parties. No officer (other than the Managing Director of ES), employee, agent or subcontractor of ES, has the authority to alter or waive any of these Terms and Conditions or to make any representation which conflicts with or purports to override any of these Terms and Conditions; and no such alteration, waiver or representation shall be binding upon ES, unless it is in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES.

2. Placement of Order

2.1 A customer order will be valid only if it is sent by mail or fax or other electronic message on letterhead of the customer or by using ES-approved sample Test request form or electronic order forms and the commercial aspects of the order which are not specifically set out in these Terms and Conditions (including price, estimated turnaround times and delivery date) must be agreed at the time of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

2.2 Unless specifically accepted in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES, any terms proposed or submitted by a customer at any time (including, but not limited to, terms or provisions in the customer's purchase order-instructions or other document) which differ from these Terms and Conditions are rejected as a material alteration of these Terms and Conditions and shall be of no force or effect. Furthermore, special terms or conditions of prior orders, including special pricing, will not automatically apply to subsequent orders. Each order accepted by ES will be treated as a separate contract between ES and the customer.

2.3 Any logistic service off-site of the laboratory must be paid in full, unless it has been cancelled or modified by the customer at least forty eight hours (48) in advance for collection services, ninety six (96) hours in advance for sampling services and one (1) week in advance for auditing services.

3. Price and Terms of Payment

3.1 If the acknowledgment of an order does not state otherwise, ES' prices apply "ex works", excluding packaging, which is charged separately. Any additional cost or disbursement (e.g. incurred by ES in connection with the order) must be paid by the customer.

3.2 Prices are exclusive of all applicable taxes (GST or Other taxes) and are based on tariffs in force at the day of the remittance of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

3.3 Unless specifically agreed otherwise by ES in its acceptance of an order, payment of all invoices is due strictly within 30 days of the invoice date. Any dispute about invoices must be raised within 30 days of the invoice date. The challenge of any test result will not entitle a customer to defer payment. Any invoice which remains outstanding after due date, may be additionally charged with an administrative penalty of Rupees Two hundred (Rs.200) and may carry interest as per MSMED Act.

3.4 Invoices are subject to a minimum invoice charge of Rupees two Hundred fifty (Rs.250).

3.5 The invoice settlement method is Cheque, bank transfer or direct debit. Any other method of payment must receive prior agreement from ES. The customer undertakes to provide bank account details.

3.6 ES is entitled to require payment of up to 100% of the quoted order price as a condition of acceptance.

4. Duties of Customer in Delivering Samples or Materials

4.1 The samples or materials must be in a condition that makes the preparation of reports/analyses or the production of ordered products possible without difficulty. ES is entitled to conduct an initial examination of the samples or materials to check their condition before processing the samples, drawing up a report or using them in production. The customer shall bear the costs of this initial examination, if the samples or materials do not comply with the requirements described in this clause 4.1. If the result of the initial examination is that an analysis or production is impossible or is possible only under more difficult conditions than originally anticipated (for example, because the samples or materials have been interspersed with foreign materials or substances that were not reported by the customer or are degraded) ES shall be entitled to terminate or interrupt the order and the customer shall bear costs incurred by ES to that point.

4.2 The customer must ensure, and hereby warrants, that no sample poses any danger, inducing on its site, during transportation, in the laboratory or otherwise to ES premises, instruments, personnel or representatives. It is the customer's responsibility to insure compliance with hazardous waste regulations, including regarding information, transportation and disposal and to inform ES personnel or representatives about sample health and safety concerns, including any known or suspected toxic or other contaminant that may be present in the sample and its likely level of contamination as well as the risks to ES premises, instruments, personnel and representatives related to the contamination. The customer shall be responsible for, and indemnifies ES against, all costs, damages, liabilities and injuries that may be caused to or incurred by ES or its personnel or representatives including on the sampling site, during the transportation or in the laboratory by the customer's sample or by sampling site conditions. The customer shall bear all extraordinary costs for adequate disposal of hazardous waste resulting from the sample, whether or not described as hazardous waste. At ES' request, the customer must provide ES with the exact composition of the samples.

5. Property Rights on Sample Material and Sample Storage

5.1 All samples become the property of ES to the extent necessary for the performance of the order. Unless the customer pays for storage, ES shall have no obligation or liability for samples sent to ES for storage, including samples requiring refrigeration however ES retains the sample for three months. If the customer pays for further storage, ES will take commercially reasonable steps to store the samples, according to professional practice.

5.2 Sample will be destroyed after one month from the date of release of test report unless specified by regulatory or ES and the customer have agreed in writing on the terms of ES' retention of the sample. ES also can dispose of or destroy the samples after the agreed upon retention period, without further notice and at customer's cost, should an extra cost for ES arise to comply with any regulation (for example, with respect to disposal of hazardous waste). If the customer requests the return of unneeded sample material, ES will return them to the customer, at the customer's cost and risk.

5.3 The sample description is not verified in all cases and is given "as described by customer". Sample not drawn by us and analysis conducted on "as received bases". Unless specified otherwise

6. Delivery Dates, Turnaround Time

6.1 Delivery dates and turnaround times are estimates and do not constitute a commitment by ES. Nevertheless, ES shall make commercially reasonable efforts to meet its estimated deadlines.

6.2 Results are generally sent by email and/or by mail, or via other electronic means, to the attention of the persons indicated by the customer in the order, promptly after the analysis is completed.

7. Transfer of Property

7.1 Title in any analysis results, products, equipment, software or similar supplied by ES to the customer will remain with ES until all invoices in respect thereof have been paid by the customer in full, and until such full payment, the customer shall have no property rights or other rights to use them. In addition, even if ES has accepted and begun to fulfil an order, ES has the right at any time stop processing that order and to stop doing any work for a customer if that customer is late in paying any amount due to ES, whether for that or any other order.

7.2 Even after payment in full by the customer, ES shall retain the right to store, use and publish all analysis results in an anonymous form which does not identify the customer.

8. Limited Warranties and responsibilities

8.1 Orders are handled in the conditions available to ES in accordance with the current state of technology and methods developed and generally applied by ES and the results may not always be 100% exact and/ or relevant. Analyses, interpretations, assessments, consulting work and conclusions are prepared with a commercially reasonable degree of care but ES cannot guarantee that these will always be correct or absolute. This limited warranty expires three months after the delivery date of the samples, if the acknowledgement of the order does not specifically state otherwise. In all cases, the customer must independently verify the validity of any results, interpretations, assessments and conclusions supplied by ES, if it wishes to rely on the same in respect of matters of importance and shall do so at its own risk.

8.2 Each testing report relates exclusively to the sample analyzed by ES. If ES has not expressly been mandated and paid for the definition of the sampling plan (including which samples of which raw materials and finished products and at which frequent should be analyzed) and the definition of the precise range of analysis to be performed or if the customer has not followed ES recommendations, ES shall not bear any responsibility if the sampling plan and/or the range of analysis to be performed prove to be insufficient or inappropriate.

9. Limitation of Liability

9.1 Except to the extent that such limitations are not permitted or void under applicable law: (a) ES (together with its workers, office clerks, employees, representatives, managers, officers, directors, agents and consultants and all ES partners and affiliates, the "ES Indemnifying Parties") shall be liable only for the proven direct and immediate damage caused by the ES Indemnifying Parties' willful misconduct in connection with the performance of an order and then, only if ES has received written notice thereof not later than six (6) months after the date of the customer's knowledge of the relevant claim (unless any longer period is prescribed under applicable law and cannot be contractually limited), and (b) in all cases (whether arising under contract, tort, negligence, strict liability, through indemnification or otherwise), the ES Indemnifying Parties' liability per claim or series of related claims, and the customer's exclusive remedy, with respect to ES' services which fall under these Terms and Conditions, shall be limited to the lesser of: (i) the direct and immediate loss or damage caused by the ES Indemnifying Parties' willful misconduct in connection with the performance of the order and (ii) Invoice amount ES actually received from the customer in relation to the order subject to maximum of Rs. 1 lac (Rupees One Lac)

9.2 The ES Indemnifying Parties shall not be liable for any indirect, direct or consequential loss or damage (including, but not limited to, loss of business, profits, goodwill, and business opportunities or similar) incurred by the customer or by any third party.

11. Force Majeure

ES cannot be held liable for delays, errors, damages or other problems caused by events or circumstances which are unforeseen or beyond ES' reasonable control, or which result from compliance with governmental requests, laws and regulations.

12. Confidentiality & Processing of Customer Data

12.1 ES shall be entitled to save and process personal or commercial data received from the customer in any way, no matter whether such data stem from the customer directly or from a third party and shall use commercially reasonable efforts to keep such data confidential, in compliance with applicable law.

12.2 ES shall use commercially reasonable efforts to keep all analysis results and service reports confidential, subject to ES' rights set forth in clause 7.2 and the right to use them in order to demonstrate its entitlement to payment for services rendered.

12.3 Analysis results are prepared and supplied exclusively for the use of the customer and should not be divulged to a third party for any purposes without the prior written agreement of ES. In addition, the customer is required to maintain secrecy concerning all services provided by ES and their results as well as the composition of products and software delivered by ES. Analysis results are not to be publicly disclosed or exploited without the prior written consent of ES. Even if such written consent is given by ES, the customer (a) remains responsible for any consequences due to the divulgence of such results to a third party and any reliance of such third party on such results and (b) hereby agrees to indemnify the ES Indemnified Parties against any liability which the ES Indemnified Parties may incur as a result of such divulgence or any such third party reliance.

12.4 Test report certificate shall not be reproduced except in full, without written permission of laboratory

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General Terms & Conditions

Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited) undertakes to provide service to its customer subject to the terms & conditions mentioned here-

1. Area of Application

1.1 All Orders accepted by **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)** (Collectively "ES") will be governed by these General Terms and Conditions of Sales (the "Terms and Conditions"), including orders placed by telephone which have not been confirmed in writing and orders made by delivery of samples. A contract with these Terms and Conditions comes into being when an order that has been placed with ES is accepted by ES. An order placed with ES is considered as accepted by ES when (a) ES proceeds to fulfil that order, without need for any written confirmation from ES or (b) ES accept the order in writing.

1.2 All reports will be issued with the legal name i.e. **Spectro Analytical Labs Private Limited (formerly Spectro Analytical Labs Limited)**

1.3 These Terms and Conditions supersede and replace all prior verbal or written price quotations and agreements between the parties and, unless specifically indicated otherwise therein, take precedence over all conflicting or inconsistent provisions of subsequent written agreements between the parties. No officer (other than the Managing Director of ES), employee, agent or subcontractor of ES has the authority to alter or waive any of these Terms and Conditions or to make any representation which conflicts with or purports to override any of these Terms and Conditions; and no such alteration, waiver or representation shall be binding upon ES, unless it is in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES.

2. Placement of Order

2.1 A customer order will be valid only if it is sent by mail or fax or other electronic message on letterhead of the customer or by using ES-approved sample Test request form or electronic order forms and the commercial aspects of the order which are not specifically set out in these Terms and Conditions (including price, estimated turnaround times and delivery date) must be agreed at the time of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

2.2 Unless specifically accepted in writing and signed by the Managing Director of ES, any terms proposed or submitted by a customer at any time (including, but not limited to, terms or provisions in the customer's purchase order-instructions or other document) which differ from these Terms and Conditions are rejected as a material alteration of these Terms and Conditions and shall be of no force or effect. Furthermore, special terms or conditions of prior orders, including special pricing, will not automatically apply to subsequent orders. Each order accepted by ES will be treated as a separate contract between ES and the customer.

2.3 Any logistic service off-site of the laboratory must be paid in full, unless it has been cancelled or modified by the customer at least forty eight hours (48) in advance for collection services, ninety six (96) hours in advance for sampling services and one (1) week in advance for auditing services.

3. Price and Terms of Payment

3.1 If the acknowledgment of an order does not state otherwise, ES' prices apply "ex works", excluding packaging, which is charged separately. Any additional cost or disbursement (e.g. incurred by ES in connection with the order) must be paid by the customer.

3.2 Prices are exclusive of all applicable taxes (GST or Other taxes) and are based on tariffs in force at the day of the remittance of the order. The customer must confirm in writing orders given by telephone immediately after they are made and will be deemed to have placed an order if the customer sends samples to ES quoting the customer reference. ES is not obligated to start any work unless the order is clear and it has been provided all required information.

3.3 Unless specifically agreed otherwise by ES in its acceptance of an order, payment of all invoices is due strictly within 30 days of the invoice date. Any dispute about invoices must be raised within 30 days of the invoice date. The challenge of any test result will not entitle a customer to defer payment. Any invoice which remains outstanding after due date, may be additionally charged with an administrative penalty of Rupees Two hundred (Rs.200) and may carry interest as per MSMED Act.

3.4 Invoices are subject to a minimum invoice charge of Rupees two Hundred fifty (Rs.250).

3.5 The invoice settlement method is Cheque, bank transfer or direct debit. Any other method of payment must receive prior agreement from ES. The customer undertakes to provide bank account details.

3.6 ES is entitled to require payment of up to 100% of the quoted order price as a condition of acceptance.

4. Duties of Customer in Delivering Samples or Materials

4.1 The samples or materials must be in a condition that makes the preparation of reports/analyses or the production of ordered products possible without difficulty. ES is entitled to conduct an initial examination of the samples or materials to check their condition before processing the samples, drawing up a report or using them in production. The customer shall bear the costs of this initial examination, if the samples or materials do not comply with the requirements described in this clause 4.1. If the result of the initial examination is that an analysis or production is impossible or is possible only under more difficult conditions than originally anticipated (e.g. for example, because the samples or materials have been interspersed with foreign materials or substances that were not reported by the customer or are degraded) ES shall be entitled to terminate or interrupt the order and the customer shall bear costs incurred by ES to that point.

If the customer pays for further storage, ES will take commercially reasonable steps to store the samples, according to professional practice.

6. Delivery Dates, Turnaround Time

6.1 Delivery dates and turnaround times are estimates and do not constitute a commitment by ES. Nevertheless, ES shall make commercially reasonable efforts to meet its estimated deadlines.

6.2 Results are generally sent by email and/or by mail, or via other electronic means, to the attention of the persons indicated by the customer in the order, promptly after the analysis is completed.

7. Transfer of Property

Sir,

This has reference to your letter dated 4th August 2014 requesting grant of permission for dumping of the dredged material at the dumping ground location recommended by CWPRS vide letter cited at reference (ii) above. In the context of maintenance dredging of 1.16 Million m³ for the RGPPL LNG Terminal, for the year 2013, CWPRS had suggested to dump the soft silt beyond (-) 24 m (CD) depth contour at a dumping site located at Latitude 17° 33' 21" N and Longitude 73° 00' 00" E. It is now communicated by RGPPL that maintenance dredging quantity of 1.3 Million m³ is proposed to be dredged during 2014 and requested for dumping the material at the above dumping ground.

While suggesting the above dumping ground for the year 2013, it was recommended to monitor the dumping ground by carrying out pre and post dumping bathymetric surveys and forward the same to CWPRS for analysis and to decide about further dumping of maintenance dredging material at this location.

Based on the data furnished by RGPPL the analysis of the pre dumping survey of October 2013 and post dumping survey of March 2014 it is observed that an average of less than 0.20 m of level difference has occurred at the dumping ground. Further the analysis report of the dredged material received indicates that the dredged material predominately comprises of clay and silt.

Since the change in the bed level at the dumping site is well within the acceptable limits and the material to be dumped is fine in nature, which would easily disperse from the dumping site, it is recommended to use the suggested dumping ground, as mentioned above, for disposal during 2014. It is also recommended that the above dumping ground may be adopted for disposal of the future annual maintenance dredging material of RGPPL LNG terminal with regular monitoring.

With reference to letters cited at (vi) above M/s RGPPL had approached CWPRS, in the past, for giving suggestions and recommendation for the disposal of the maintenance dredging material from the Turning Circle and Approach Channel of LNG Terminal at Anjanwel. CWPRS vide reference (v) above had suggested dumping site at Latitude 17° 33' 21"N and Longitude 73° 00' 00"E for the maintenance dredging quantity of 1.16 Mm³, which comprised mainly soft silt material.

Subsequent to that, during the year 2014, RGPPL approached CWPRS, once again, vide reference (iv) above for further suggestion for dumping of about 1.3 Mm³ of annual maintenance dredging material. Based on the analysis of bathymetric survey data of dumping ground provided by RGPPL for year 2013, CWPRS recommended vide reference (iii) to continue to use the dumping site suggested earlier. In the recommendation it was also suggested to continue regular monitoring of the dumping ground by carrying out pre and post dredging and dumping surveys in the Approach Channel, Turning Circle including the Dumping Ground. It was also mentioned to keep records of dredging details like duration, quantity and type of material for each year to take further decision on the future suitability of dumping ground. This data was essential for assessing the material dispersion efficiency at the designated site.

With reference to the letter under (ii) above and the meeting held at CWPRS on 04/5/2018 with Shri Ramji Gupta, DGM, Konkan LNG Private Limited (KLPL), it was informed that during the month of February, 2018, LNG business of M/s Ratnagiri Gas and Power Private Limited (RGPPL) was demerged into a separate company named KLPL. In view of the formation of the new company, KLPL requested CWPRS to review and recommend the dumping ground for the annual maintenance dredging material, mainly comprising soft silt at the existing LNG Terminal.

M/s KLPL provided the data regarding the annual maintenance dredging from the year 2014 to 2017 along with details of dredging periods and material classification to CWPRS for further suggestion on the dumping ground for the future maintenance dredging. The quantity of maintenance dredging in previous years is as below:

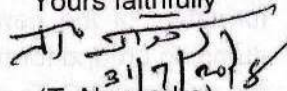
M/s KLPL also provided the pre and post dredging bathymetric survey data of Dumping Ground, Approach Channel and Turning Circle for years 2014 -2017 to CWPRS. Based on the desk study analysis, for the data provided, the following were observed:

- 1) The quantity of the maintenance dredging has varied from 0.8Mm³ to 1.3Mm³
- 2) The dredged material comprised of soft silt which is very fine and is not suitable for land reclamation and it is not fit for the land disposal at the site as well.
- 3) The number of dredging days varied from 50 to 75 days, depending on the quantity of dredging. It was maximum during the year 2017 wherein the total quantity of dredging was 1.3 Mm³.
- 4) For the year 2017, the year in which maximum dredging was carried out the studies indicated a net accumulation of about 1,05,791 m³ at the end of dredging schedule. This implies an average increase of dumping site level by about 0.08m, which is well within the disposal norms. Further it is anticipated that the remaining material will also disperse after the Monsoon and over a period of time without causing any undesirable shallowing at the site.
- 5) Further the annual pre-dredging bathymetric data for different years at the dumping site has indicated no significant annual accumulation of the dumped material at the dumping site. This indicates that the material dumped disperses away from this region over a period of about 3-4 months after the dumping.
- 6) Major part of the material dumped has moved away to deeper regions immediately after dumping and for this reason no shallowing at the approach channel, turning circle or in vicinity was observed during these years while the LNG vessels were in operation.

Based on the above observations it is recommended to continue the dumping of the annual maintenance dredging material at the suggested location i.e. at Latitude 17° 33' 21"N and Longitude 73° 00' 00"E. Further, it is also suggested to continue monitoring of the dumping ground by carrying out pre and post dumping bathymetric surveys, record of dredging schedule, type of material etc., and this data may be regularly forwarded to CWPRS for further analysis.

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1. PURPOSE

The LNG terminal is characterized by an approach channel of 8 Km, 300 meter wide and a turning circle of 700 mtrs basin, LNG Jetty and the partially completed Breakwater. The Annual maintenance dredging is required is to be carried out at the turning basin and along the approach channel and near Jetty for ensuring the requisite depth for bringing the LNG Cargo. Based on the available data & past experience, a contract for the period of Three years with an estimated dredging quantity of 18 lacs m³ (approx.) per annum consisting of soft silt, clay, stray boulders, etc for achieving the requisite depth for bringing the LNG Cargo.

3. SITE LOCATION

The site located at Village - Anjanwel, Taluka – Guhagar, District – Ratnagiri - 415634, Maharashtra, India. The Project site, Dabhol is on the West coast near Chiplun and is well connected by road and rail. KLL plant is located 300 km from Mumbai and can be accessed by Road & Train. Chiplun is Nearest Railway station & Mumbai is nearest airport (Domestic as well as International).



4. EQUIPMENT

The plant and equipment that will be involved in the execution of the project comprises of:

- Trailer Suction Hopper Dredger "Shanti Sagar – IV"
- Crew Boat

5. SCOPE OF WORK

Test Sample: All samples shall be supplied by the Contractor at his own cost if the supply thereof is clearly intended by or provided for in the Contract. Samples shall be collected from the hopper, zone wise at 3 different stages viz., initial, midway and final stages of dredging period of each zone. During each stage minimum of 3 samples at different depths of hopper shall be taken in each zone. The following Tests for the dredged material shall be carried out by the Contractor:

- i) Bulk density
- ii) Particle Size distribution
- iii) Dry density
- iv) Specific Gravity
- v) Water Content

As per the contract the dredging area consists of 3 zones:

Zone 1: KP 0.0 to KP 3.0

Zone 2: KP 3.0 to KP 5.0

Zone 3: KP 5.0 to KP 8.0

So the samples to be collected as per Zone wise and stages and at different depth of Hopper, we need to collect **27 samples** for one Campaign. We need to submit a final test (sample) report prior to the submission of final bill, as specified, on the dredging works carried out.

We have appointed **VPM's Maharshi Parshuram College of Engineering, Velneshwar** for providing the material testing and consultancy services.

The college is affiliated to University of Mumbai and approved by AICTE. It is accredited by NAAC with Grade 'D' in 2019.

They are having three years of experience in material testing in field of Concrete technology, Geotechnical engineering, highway engineering and Environmental engineering.

In their Geotechnical Engineering following test as specified above can be done.
